In 1990 Ms. Olivero moved to New York City for more opportunities both personally and professionally. In New York she continued studies at the Department of Political Science at Lehman College, CUNY. Ms. Olivero has been engaged in the field of medical administration in the Dominican Republic and New York City. Currently she serves as Marketing Director for NY Physical Therapy & Orthopedic Medical Pavilion.

In 2017 Ms. Olivero created The Dominican Heritage and Culture Society (DHCS) in an effort to give back to the people she loves by promoting the culture, history and arts of the Domincans in the United States. Ms. Olivero is married to Mohammad Momani, an engineer; she is the mother of three children: Carlos Vitinni, JD, Omar Momani and Nur Momani.



Seny Taveras is first and foremost a Dominican Woman from Washington Heights, New York, who has dedicated nearly all of her adult life to public service.

Currently, Mrs. Taveras serves as Executive Director of the National Supermarket Association. Prior to her time at NSA, Mrs. Taveras was the Chairperson of the Department of Legal Studies at ASA College where she oversaw the programs and courses by developing long and short-term goals. Before that, she was Executive Director of CUNY In the Heights, Hostos Community College, Department of Continuing Education and Workforce Development and oversaw a broad range of fiscal and program responsibilities for Continuing Education and related external programs. She was also Chief of

the Staff for DAP Strategies, LLC, a consulting company that advises on international business and political consulting, where she was responsible for strategic planning for a sector of the company's international portfolio.

A lifelong public servant, Mrs. Taveras served as Chief of the Staff to Councilmember Ydanis Rodriguez (District 10) in Manhattan. In that capacity, she is charged with the entire operation of his office. Mrs. Taveras managed budget, legislation and day-today operations. She also worked as Special Assistant to New York State Deputy Secretary Denise O'Donnell, Public Safety and Homeland Security. In that capacity, she influenced policies and operations for the state's homeland security, emergency preparedness, and criminal justice agencies. In addition, she served as Senior Policy Advisor to Lieutenant Governor David A. Paterson and Special Counsel for New York State Senator David A. Paterson. Dominican.



two Emmy nominations and many special recognitions from diverse organizations.



















# THE INFLUENTIAL DOMINICAN AMBASSADOR AWARD

Samuel Collado was born in May 1967 in Janico, a small rural town in the city of Santiago, Dominican Republic. As the son of Mr. Eladio Collado, a remarkable businessman, and Mrs. Silvia Baez, a fascinating educator, academics were a big part of Samuels home life. His early education was received at the Salesian School in Jarabacoa. Samuel subsequently graduated from the Catholic University of Santiago (PUCMM) with a degree in Business Administration and Human Resources. In 1988, Samuel decided to pursue a new skyline and came to New York where he started working in the Supermarket industry with the White Rose Group (AKA Pioneer). Samuel acquired dreams that only a determined man with dreams could attain. The following year, he made his first business acquisition, a small grocery store and a used car dealership in Connecticut, which would only be the beginning of a successful journey. In 1993, returning to New York he purchased his first Supermarket in Astoria, Queens and at the same time, he became a proud member of the prestigious and Unique "National Supermarket Association." Being part of the NSA has been an aid of immeasurable value to him, as it enables Samuel to keep servicing the community.


